Kindergarten

Weeks of May 14th and May 21st



This Week:

Reading/Writing:

- Stories: The Very Hungry Caterpillar and other Eric Carle books
- Long vowels
- Writing activities about kindergarten
- Review of consonant, vowel, consonant words (CVC words)
- Story recall
- Continue spelling popcorn words, and all word family words

Math:

- Drawing pictures for "Some, Some Went Away" stories
- Identifying and making symmetrical designs
- Comparing heights or lengths of objects
- Dividing a whole into 2 equal parts
- Acting out some, some went away stories

Science/Social Studies

- Continue with life cycle of a butterfly

On going activities:

- journals, sounds, popcorn words, beginning sounds, calendar, writing last name, sentence writing, segmenting words (stretch out short vowel words orally saying each sound), rhyming words, opposites, nonsense words, review consonant, vowel, consonant words (CVC words)

Reminders:

- We will be having a pizza party on the last day of school. Your child will not be eating in the cafeteria the last day.

Practice at Home:

- Review letters, sounds, beginning sounds and popcorn words as needed

- Practice number words
- Review seasons

These last two weeks we will be introducing long vowels and continue learning about butterflies. There will be no homework for the remainder of the school year!
