



Here's What's Happening in Kindergarten

Week of December 12th



This Week:

Reading/Writing:

- Stories: Benjamin Bunny, The Blue Balloon, Penelope Pig, Lilly's Purple Plastic Purse.
- Letters Bb and Pp – Identify uppercase and lowercase, /b/ and /p/ sound, letter formation, brainstorm words that begin with the short /b/ and /p/ sound
- Writing activities
- Sound spell words that begin with the /b/ and /p/ sound
- Christmas Journal

Math:

- Graphing
- Patterning
- Addition
- Telling time to the hour
- Sorting

Science/Social Studies:

- Holiday projects
- Signs and symbols

On going activities:

- letters, sounds, journals, phonics cards, popcorn words, beginning sounds, calendar, handwriting strokes, writing first name, sentence writing (spacing between words, first letter of sentence uppercase, using a period), using pointer finger to touch under words when reading, recall and retell information from the stories we read, segment words (stretch out short vowel words orally saying each sound), rhyming words

Reminders:

- Pajama Day – Tuesday, Dec. 13th (wear your PJ's to school)
- Bring a teddy bear to school – Thursday, Dec., 15th
- Return library book weekly

Practice at Home:

- Practice writing first name using correct uppercase and lowercase letters
- Review letters, sounds and beginning sounds as needed
- Practice counting – 100 is the end of the year goal
- Practice tying shoes and zipping coats
- Practice stating address, birthday and phone number

This week we will work on letters p and b and work on some special Christmas projects. Your child will also make a Christmas Tree addition game to play at home. Your child is invited to wear his/her pajamas to school on Tuesday and bring a teddy bear on Thursday. Thank you for continuing to work on homework activities at home!
